Changing File associations

Directions on how to associate a file type with a specific program.

1. Open Windows Explorer. If you right mouse click on the Start button you can choose Explore. This is Window's Explorer.
2. Find a file that is the native file type for the program you want to have it associated with. For example: a .brf file is the native format for the BES Lettering program. Locate a file with that file extension.
3. Right mouse click on the file and choose Properties.
4. You will see Opens With in the window that pops up. Click the Change button.
5. Then click the Browse button.
6. Browse for the .exe file that you want to use to open this type file. For BES lettering, you will look in Program Files\Pacesetter\BESLettering\Beslet.exe.
7. Double click on Beslet.exe or click Open.
8. Click OK.
9. Make sure there is a checkmark in front of Always use the Selected program to open this type file.
10. Click OK again.
11. Your file association has been changed.
